

## CCRA Awards 2011

In 2011, the CCRA initiated a biennial recognition program to acknowledge the contributions of individuals who have had a remarkable impact on cancer research and the cancer research community. The three inaugural recipients were:



**Dr. Philip E. Branton**, who received the award for Exceptional Leadership in Cancer Research for his outstanding contributions to the development of the cancer research community and inter-agency research collaboration in Canada through the founding of CCRA.



**Dr. Anthony J. Pawson**, who received the award for Outstanding Achievements in Cancer Research for his revolutionary work in cancer signal transduction leading to novel therapies for cancer patients.



**Mr. André Picard**, who received the award for Distinguished Service to Cancer Research for his contributions to public education on cancer research and policy through exemplary journalism.
