

CCRA Awards 2013

In 2013, the CCRA recognized the contributions of the following three individuals who have had a remarkable impact on cancer research and the cancer research community. The three recipients were:



Dr. Victor Ling received the award for Exceptional Leadership in Cancer Research for his outstanding contributions to the leadership of cancer research, including his role as the visionary inaugural leader of the Terry Fox Research Institute and his contribution to the development of a Canadian strategy for cancer control which ultimately led to the formation of the Canadian Partnership Against Cancer.



Dr. John E. Dick received the award for Outstanding Achievements in Cancer Research for his seminal research and leadership in the field of stem cell research, including his role in providing the first proof that cancer stem cells are not created equally.



Mr. Bob McDonald received the award for Distinguished Service to Cancer Research for his dedication to science education and communication through radio as a broadcaster and author.
